Ask the person to 'stick' out their tongue. If the tongue is 'crooked,' and if it goes to one side or the other, that is also an indication of a stroke.

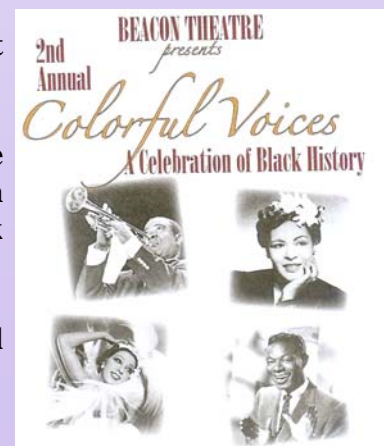
Howard will be traveling to Fort Knox KY, in April 2008, to instruct PBUSE training to various students.
